### Applying Tags:

- Officially identify all animals in accordance with Animal Disease Traceability Rule and state of destination animal health requirements;
- Maintain each animal's identity before comingling and until an official eartag is applied to ensure the official identification can be correlated to the consignor of the animal;
- Apply official eartags ONLY to animals not already officially identified; and
- Do not remove official identification devices unless authorized by an animal health official.

Tag Application & Record Keeping: The record must include, at a minimum:

- The date the official identification eartags were applied;
- The official identification numbers of the tags applied and associated with the owner or person responsible for the animals;
- The name, physical address, city, state and zip code of the consignor of animals tagged.

**Recordkeeping:** Maintain records of official identification eartags received and applied for a minimum of five years. Also maintain an accurate inventory of tags and records.

**Security:** Ensure the security of official eartags, application records and inventory. Limit accessibility to only tag applicator personnel. Immediately report any lost or stolen tags to Colorado animal health officials.

#### **Ordering Tags:**

- 840 tags are available from approved manufacturers and distributors.
- Silver metal National Uniform Eartagging System (NUES) tags or "brite" tags can be ordered from CDA's Rocky Mountain Regional Animal Health Laboratory (RMRAHL) by an accredited veterinarian or producer.
